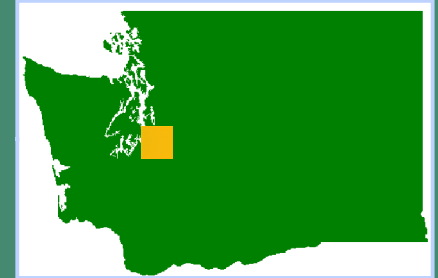


Pierce County Transit Flooding

Pierce County transit routes measured as a percentage of vulnerability in the event of severe flooding. Routes at the highest risk of flooding (20-40% chance) are highlighted in red, the least at risk (0.5-10% chance) are highlighted in green, all others fall between these two risk values. As it holds a disproportionate amount of the total Pierce County transit routes, the city of Tacoma is the
